## Overview

---

The Indiana Education Scholarship Account (ESA) Program was established during the 2021 legislative session and launched for the 2022-2023 school year. Administered by the Office of the Treasurer of State, the program provides qualifying students with disabilities throughout the state of Indiana the flexibility to spend dedicated scholarship money on approved educational programs and expenses.

Participating students are entitled to receive 90% of basic tuition support, as well as 100% of special education dollars allotted to the student, by the state, if the student chooses not to receive special education services from their local public school. The basic tuition support varies by school district and is based on the student's school corporation of legal residence.

Funds were disbursed into each student's account on the following quarterly schedule: July 17, October 16, January 16, and April 16. The first year that the account is established, a student may roll over up to \$1,000 of unused funds. For every subsequent year, a student may roll over \$1,000 plus any amount rolled over in a previous year.

## Eligibility

---

### Student Eligibility Criteria

Student must:

1. Have legal and primary residency in the state of Indiana;
2. Be at least five years of age and less than twenty-two years of age on August 1 of the school year;
3. Have a disability at the time the account is established, with a developed Individualized Education Plan (IEP), Service Plan (SP), ESA Service Plan (ESA SP) or Choice Special Education Plan (CSEP); and
4. Meet the annual income requirement for the Choice Scholarship Program.
  - a. Income Eligibility Criteria: is a member of a household with an annual income of not more than four hundred percent (400%) of the amount required for the individual to qualify for the federal free or reduced price lunch program.

## Participating Entity Eligibility Criteria

Per IC 20-51.4-2-6, a participating entity is defined as “an individual or entity authorized by the Treasurer of State to participate” in the ESA program. The following types of providers are eligible to become participating entities:

1. Qualified school, defined by IC 20-51.4-2-10 as “a nonpublic school accredited by either the state board or a national or regional accreditation agency that is recognized by the state board and to which an eligible student is required to pay tuition to attend and that agrees to enroll an eligible student.”
2. Individual tutor or tutoring agency.
3. Individual or entity providing services in accordance with the eligible student’s IEP or Service Plan.
4. Individual or entity offering a course or program to an eligible student.
5. Licensed occupational therapist.
6. Entities that provide assessments.

## Participation

---

### Student Participation

For the purpose of this report, a participating student is defined as any student who received an ESA payment for the 2023-2024 school year, regardless of whether the student maintained an account for the entirety of the school year.

For the 2023-2024 school year, the student application period was open from March 1, 2023, through September 1, 2023. During the application window, a total of 957 unique ESA applications were created, an increase of over 300% from the previous year. Of those applications, an estimated 557 ESA applications were approved. Ultimately, the total number of participating students was 540 for the 2023-2024 school year. A more detailed breakdown of the year-over-year change in participation can be found at the end of the report, in the 2023-2024 ESA Student Summary.

### Participating Entity Participation

Since its launch on April 25, 2022, the application for participating entities has remained open on a rolling basis. As of March 1, 2024, there were 329 unique approved business and individual providers participating in the 2023-2024 school year, with multiple providers operating at more than one site. Likewise, an additional 63 unique schools were approved for ESA participation, for a total of 392 unique participating entities for 2023-2024.

Of those 63 schools, 44 were qualified schools, with the remaining 19 participating as a school business entity. Data pertaining to ESA participant enrollment and qualifying award amounts to qualified schools can be found in Appendices A and B, respectively.

### Student Participation by Grade Level

There were students represented in every grade level in the 2023-2024 group of ESA participants. A full breakdown of participation by grade level can be found in Tables 1a and 1b on the following pages.

## Student Participation by Gender

Nearly two-thirds of the ESA participants were male, as indicated by Tables 2a and 2b below. This number represents a decrease of approximately 5% from the previous year, in which nearly 69% of participating students were male.

### Student Participation by Ethnicity

The following ethnicities were represented in the pool of participating ESA students for the 2023-2024 school year: Asian; Black; Hispanic; Multiracial; and White, which is a slightly more diverse group than the preceding year. ### Student Participation by Geographic Area

The vast majority of 2023-2024 ESA participants reside in either a suburban or metropolitan area, with less than 20% of participants residing in a town or rural area. These figures are relatively consistent from the previous year, although residence in a town or suburban area both decreased, while residence in a rural or metropolitan area both increased. A full breakdown of participants by geographic area follows in Tables 4a and 4b.

### Student Participation by Prior Indiana Public School Attendance

Approximately 75% of participating ESA students have, at some point over their school careers, attended an Indiana public school, as illustrated by Tables 5a and 5b below. This percentage has remained relatively steady from the previous year, with an increase of less than 4%.

### Student Participation by School Type Attended During 2022-2023 School Year

Based on the previous school year, the largest group of participating ESA students can be found in the “Other” category, which is a compilation that may include homeschool, attendance at an out-of-state school, and/or a non-accredited school. Among the defined categories, the largest number of students attended a public school in 2022-2023. Independent Non-Public Schools and Non-Public Organizations are differentiated by whether the school is operated by a diocese. A complete breakdown of numbers and percentages can be found in Tables 6a and 6b.

### Student Participation by Prior Choice Scholarship Program Participation

The 2023-2024 school year saw a decrease in the percentage of ESA students who have previously participated in the Choice Scholarship Program. Less than one-fifth of participating ESA students indicate previous receipt of a Choice Scholarship since the program's inception in 2011. ## Participant Retention

### Retention During 2023-2024 School Year

For the 2023-2024 cohort, of the 540 ESA participants, 105 accounts had been terminated as of March 1, 2024, leaving a total of 435 active ESA accounts that have received payment during the 2023-2024 school year. Approximately 80% of funded accounts were active as of March 1, 2024, as referenced in Tables 8a and 8b. This percentage remains consistent from the previous year, in which 81% of participants remained active through March 1, 2023.

A full-year analysis of the 2022-2023 group of ESA participants confirmed that an additional seven participants had their ESA accounts terminated between March 2, 2023, and June 30, 2023. Therefore, the total number of 2022-2023 ESA participants who retained their account for the entirety of the school year decreased from 137 to 130.

### Retention Between Years

Now in its second year of operation, this year offered the opportunity to look at ESA participant retention between years, or the number of ESA participants who participated in both 2022-2023 and 2023-2024. When looking at returning participants, there were 112 ESA participants from 2022-2023 who were also approved and funded for ESA participation in 2023-2024, indicating that approximately 66% of participants continued their participation in the ESA program year over year, as indicated by Table 9b below.

## Qualified Award Amounts

---

### 90% Qualified Award Amounts By Grade

Per Indiana Code, an eligible ESA student is annually entitled to receive 90% of the basic state tuition support based on the student’s corporation of legal settlement. When isolated to grade level, the highest total qualified award amount would be allocated to fifth grade, which is supported by the data that the highest number of participating ESA students are currently enrolled in fifth grade. Table 10, on the following page, shows the total of 90% awards grouped by grade level.

## 2023-2024 ESA Student Summary

The following description of the “average” ESA student is based solely on data found within this ESA Report. “Average” refers to the most common descriptor within each data set.

The “average” ESA student is male and of a white ethnicity, from a metropolitan setting and currently enrolled in fifth grade. Additionally, the “average” ESA student has, at some point, attended an Indiana public school, has not previously participated in the Choice Scholarship Program, and has retained an active ESA account throughout the 2023-2024 school year. The average 90% award amount is \$6,236.



Compared to last year's "average" ESA student, many of the demographics have remained consistent. The most common geographic area has shifted from suburban to metropolitan, and the most common grade level from fourth grade to fifth grade. As would be expected with annual changes to school funding, the average 90% award has also increased by approximately \$30.

Having just completed the second full year of implementation, it is likely that the program will continue to grow as it matures. From the first to second year of implementation, the program saw a student application increase of over 300%, as well as an overall participant increase of nearly 320%. Likewise, provider participation jumped by just under 300%. Likely adding to growth will be the expansion of the program in 2024-2025 to allow siblings of eligible ESA students to apply for an account, a decision finalized during the 2024 legislative session.
