Reported TB cases: **99 cases**

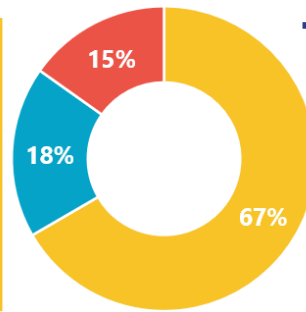
TB deaths: **7 cases**

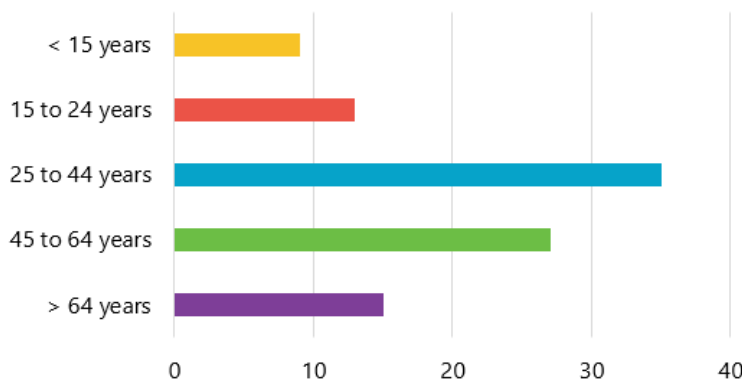

TB Cases by Age Group



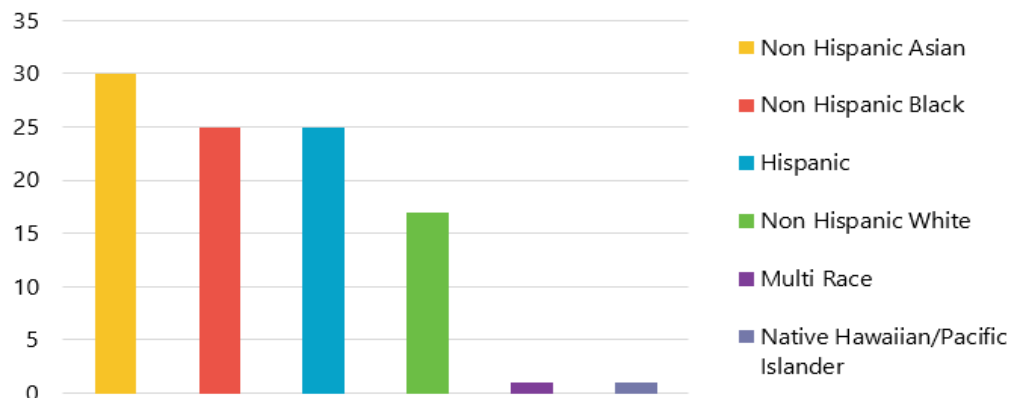
Most Reported Risk Factors

- Diabetes Mellitus – 22.2%
- Contact of Infectious TB patient – 9.1%
- Immunosuppression (not HIV/AIDS) - 6.1%
- End Stage Renal Disease – 5.1%
- History of homelessness – 5.1%
- Excess alcohol Use (past year) - 4.0%
- Non-injection Drug Use (past year) - 4.0%

TB Cases by Country of Birth

- Non-U.S.-Born: 67.7%
- U.S.-Born: 32.3%
