Indiana Public Library Standards The Indiana Library & Historical Board is charging a taskforce to conduct an initial review of the first two years of the new Public Library Standards (590 IAC 6). The Indiana State Library is seeking input from directors and trustees from libraries based upon both size and geographical distribution around the state. Meetings will be every other month, convened for the duration of 2014 and final recommendations made to the ILHB by its December 12, 2014 meeting.
