### How to Direct Link to Individual Databases

The links on the Databases A-Z and Databases by Subject pages uses the same geoip checks as the main INSPIRE interface. This allows direct access to all the individual databases.

You can get the correct URLs from either the <u>Databases A-Z</u>, or <u>Databases by Subject</u> page. From one of those pages hover over the database name, right click on the link, and choose "copy shortcut" from the drop down menu.
