ORDER ON FACT FINDING HEARING

- The Prosecutor, Andrew Wignall, Esq., was present and Permittee, Ric Joe Huddleston appeared for the Fact-Finding hearing.
- 2. Evidence was heard and presented.
- 3. Excise Officer Robert Miller testified and the evidence in Exhibit #1 and Exhibit #2 were offered and received into evidence without objection, and the records of the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles disclosed that the Permittee has two (2) unrelated convictions for operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated, on October 17, 2017 and on May 27, 2022, and that the dates therefore qualify as being within ten (10)) years of each other.
- 4. Permittee, Ric Joe Huddleston, did not deny the convictions but states that he makes his living bartending and that he has filed in February 2024 to have his 2017 conviction expunged, which has not been ruled on as it is set for Aprill 11, 2024.
- IC 7.1-3-18-9 states that a Permittee may not hold a license to serve alcoholic beverages if
 the Permittee has two (2) unrelated convictions (in this matter the Permittee has 2) for
 operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated.
- 6. The Hearing Judge finds that the convictions of the Permittee for two (2) unrelated offenses of operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated within ten (10) years in this matter are true and warrant the revocation of the above-entitled permit.
- 7. Pursuant to IC 7.1-3-23-5, the Commission shall revoke a permit of any type on account of the violations of or refusal to comply with a provision of Title 7.1 or a rule or regulation of the

Commission, which must be found by a preponderance of the evidence, which has been done.

- 8. The hearing on March 7, 2024, was held in the manner prescribed under IC 7.1-3-23-6.
- 9. Under IC 7.1-3-23-9, the Permittee is hereby advised that he may seek judicial review of this action by following IC 4-21.5-5 and has 15 days to so appeal this revocation.
- 10. Based upon the information and evidence presented at the hearing on March 7, 2024, the above-mentioned permit issued to Ric Joe Huddleston under BR1957763, by the ATC, is hereby revoked.
- 11. This revocation order will be scheduled for a final determination at a hearing before the ATC Commission.

IT IS THERFORE ORDERED that the permit issued to Ric Joe Huddleston under BR1957763 by the ATC is hereby revoked, subject to a hearing before the ATC Commission
