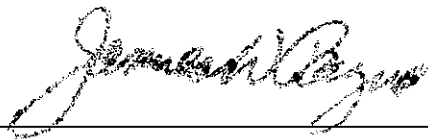
HEARING ON SHOW CAUSE HEARING

Comes now the Hearing Judge for the Indiana Alcohol and Tobacco Commission (ATC) and for the Order on Rule to Show Cause states as follows:

1. Andrew Wignall appears as Prosecutor.
2. No appearance was filed, and no one appeared for the Show Cause Hearing on June 4, 2026, at 10:00 AM.
3. The Permittee had previously failed to appear, after appropriate notice was given, pursuant to 905 IAC 1-27-9, for a Notice of Violation and Settlement Offer.
4. The Hearing Judge set this matter for Rule to Show Cause hearing on June 4, 2026, at 10:00 AM, which order was sent to the Permittee by certified mail.
5. The Notice indicated that, if the Permittee failed to appear, a default judgment shall be issued against the permit and a sanction imposed which could include suspension or revocation of the permit.
6. The Certified letter sent by ATC to the Permittee was returned by the US Post Office with the notation "Return to Sender, Unable to Forward, Return to Sender".
7. The Indiana State Excise Police report of the incident number EX25-000020 was offered and received into evidence as Exhibit #1.
8. Evidence revealed in Exhibit #1, offered and received into evidence without objection, that On December 31, 2024, an Indiana State Excise Police Officer conducted a compliance check at the Permittee's place of business and that the clerk failed to check identification of the minor purchasing alcohol, that the minor was allowed to loiter at the location and that the individual employee sold the can of beer to the underage individual.

9. Since no one on behalf of or the Permittee has appeared for this Order to Show Cause Hearing, the Hearing Judge finds by a preponderance of the evidence contained in Exhibit #1, EX25-000020, that the violation filed in this matter is true and warrants the revocation of the above-entitled permit.
 10. Pursuant to IC 7.1-3-23-5 the Commission shall revoke a permit on account of the violation of or refusal to comply with IC Title 7.1 or a rule or regulation of the Commission, which must be found by a preponderance of the evidence, which has been done.
 11. Pursuant to IC 7.1-3-23-6 the Commission shall give at least 10 days' notice to the holder of the permit proposed to be revoked, which notice was given and informed the Permittee of the time and place of the hearing to be held regarding the proposed revocation.
 12. The hearing on June 4, 2026, was held in the manner prescribed under IC 7.1-3-23-6.
 13. Under IC 7.1-3-23-9 the Permittee is hereby advised that it may seek judicial review of this action by following IC 4-21.5-5 and has 15 days to appeal this revocation.
 14. Based upon the information and evidence presented at the hearing on June 4, 2026, the above-mentioned permit issued to SASR Enterprise LLC permit DL54-32373 by the ATC is hereby revoked.
 15. The revocation order will be set for a hearing of approval before the ATC Commission.
- IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the permit issued to SASR Enterprise LLC permit DL54-32373 is hereby revoked, subject to a hearing before the ATC Commission.

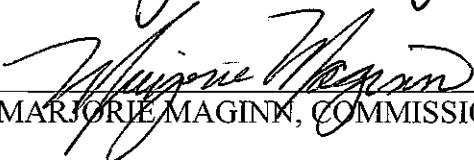
