Excise Police Cite 24 for Underage Drinking at Fraternity

FT. WAYNE, Ind. (Oct. 29) – Indiana State Excise Police officers cited 24 people for underage drinking at a fraternity party in Fort Wayne Friday night.

At approximately 11:15 p.m., excise police and Ft. Wayne police responded to a disturbance call at Sigma Pi Gamma, 1115 E. Washington Blvd. A man said he was harassed by underage drinkers as he walked by.

As a result of the investigation, 24 people were cited for illegal consumption. Two coolers of "jungle juice" (which contains Vodka), beer, bottles of liquor and numerous "Jello shots" were found and destroyed.

Twenty-four people, including two juveniles, were issued summonses on charges of minor consuming alcohol.

All minors cited will have court dates in Allen Superior Court.

The two juveniles were released to their parents and cited through Juvenile Probation.

Indiana State Excise Police officers are the enforcement division of the Indiana Alcohol & Tobacco Commission. While excise officers have the authority to enforce any state law, they focus primarily on enforcing Indiana's alcohol and tobacco statutes.
