Police Arrest Four People on Whitewater River

Brookville, Ind. (Aug. 8) – Indiana State Excise Police officers arrested four people on six charges on Whitewater River in Franklin County Saturday.

Responding to previous complaints from residents along the river, excise officers regularly patrol the river and surrounding areas looking for alcohol, tobacco and related violations.

Saturday they arrested four people on the following charges:

One minor (age 18-20) was issued a summons for illegal possession of an alcoholic beverage.

Two adults (age 21+) were arrested for public intoxication, one of whom was also charged with disorderly conduct and resisting law enforcement. A third adult was issued a ticket for littering.

Those ticketed will appear in Franklin Circuit Court on Aug. 30.

"Excise police will continue to work with Indiana Conservation Officers and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office to ensure Indiana is a safe place to live, work and raise a family," Superintendent Matt Strittmatter said. "We will persist in our efforts to ensure that the remaining weeks of summer will be safe for everyone participating in outdoor activities."
