I want to take a moment to acknowledge the challenges many public educators face today. Recently, some of our colleagues have unfortunately been the target of **doxing**, which is when personal information such as home/work addresses, phone numbers, or other private details are shared online without consent, often to intimidate or harass. We know this is upsetting, and I want to offer guidance to help protect your personal privacy and well-being.

While everyone has the right to share personal opinions on their own time, please remember that as educators and public figures, our words can sometimes attract more scrutiny than we intend. To reduce the risk of unwanted attention, consider these steps:

- · Review privacy settings: Limit personal posts to "Friends Only" or a restricted audience when possible.
- · Think before posting: Assume that anything shared online could become public, regardless of settings.
- Separate personal and professional identities: Use distinct accounts if you wish to engage in political or personal commentary.
- Avoid sharing sensitive personal information: Protect details like your home address, phone number, or family information.
- Report harassment: If you experience doxing or online threats, notify your supervisor and HR immediately so we can support you.

This is <u>NOT</u> a restriction on what you can say or do in your personal time. Rather, it is a reminder that public platforms can carry unintended risks, and I want to equip you with tools to protect yourself.

Most importantly, please know that if you face online harassment, you are not alone. The district will stand with you and offer assistance.
