FINAL ORDER

1. This matter comes before me as a result of a Notice of Appeal filed by Petitioner [REDACTED] ("Lane") by letter of January 23, 2014 seeking administrative review of a decision by the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles ("BMV") to impose a driving privilege suspension for "Delinquent Child Support" (suspension 6) upon [REDACTED].
2. This matter was referred to Administrative Law Judge Pamela Walters, Esq. per Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-27(a) for review and the issuance of a Recommended Order, which was completed on January 10, 2014. A copy of the Recommended Order issued by ALJ Walters is attached hereto and incorporated as if fully stated herein.
3. On January 23, 2014, [REDACTED] submitted an Objection to the Recommended Order per Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-29(d). He cites as grounds for his objection that he "wasn't aware of any hearing" and "during the time of my suspension, I was making my payment."
4. The Recommended Order is hereby AFFIRMED. [REDACTED]'s Objection is OVERRULED and his Notice of Appeal is hereby DENIED. [REDACTED]'s suspension will remain in place, as required by Indiana law. Any issues related to the child support issues that gave rise to the Order requiring the BMV to suspend [REDACTED]'s license must be taken up with the agency that issued the Order: the Child Support Division of the Marion County Prosecutor's Office.

5. Petitioner [REDACTED] is hereby notified that this is a FINAL ORDER. Petitioner may seek judicial review of this FINAL ORDER by filing a petition for review with the appropriate court within thirty (30) days after the date that notice of this FINAL ORDER was served, plus three (3) additional days if notice is served through the United States mail. See: Ind. Code §§ 4-21.5-3-2, 4-21.5-5.
6. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-32, this FINAL ORDER shall be made available for public inspection and copying. It shall be indexed by name and subject. All identifying details shall be deleted from the public copy of this Order per Ind. Code § 5-14-3, with written justification for all deletions explained in writing and attached to the public copy of this FINAL ORDER.
