BMV Announces New Opportunities for Driving Skills Tests

INDIANAPOLIS— The Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) announced changes that bring more opportunity to eligible individuals seeking a driver's license, permit, or identification card (credential) in Indiana.

House Enrolled Act 1050-2023 (HEA 1050) allows licensed driver training schools to administer a driving skills test to individuals who hold a valid learner's permit. Prior to this change, individuals were not eligible to complete a driving skills test until 90 days after they turned 16, which often occurs after the training courses have taken place for many permit holders.
