BMV Announces Changes Providing Additional Opportunities to Ukrainians Displaced into the United States

INDIANAPOLIS— The Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) announced changes bringing more opportunity to eligible individuals seeking a driver's license, permit, or identification card (credential) in Indiana.

House Enrolled Act 1050-2023 (HEA 1050) provides the BMV the authority to issue a non-Real ID compliant credential to certain Ukrainian nationals paroled into the U.S. Additionally, the new law instructs the BMV to adopt emergency rules to allow that same group to title and register their vehicles in Indiana. Those applying for credentials under this law must provide all required documentation and pass any necessary tests to obtain a credential.
