BMV Wabash Branch is Relocating

Wabash, IN – September 24, 2025— The Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) Wabash branch is relocating from its current address at 1679 N. Cass St., Wabash, IN 46992, to a new location at 403 S. Cass St., Ste. A, Wabash, IN 46992.

The last day of operations at the current location will be Monday, October 6, 2025. The new branch location will open on Friday, October 10, 2025, and will maintain the same hours of operation:

Monday: 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Wednesday: 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Friday: 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

The new Wabash branch will provide increased capacity as the BMV continues striving to enhance services and add transaction capacity. The branch will increase from 5 to 6 customer service stations and will feature a BMV Connect kiosk. BMV Connect kiosks are available to customers to complete more than a dozen transactions 24-hours a day, seven days a week, in English or Spanish.

Customers needing to complete business at a branch during this relocation process, can visit the Peru branch. The Peru branch, which is normally closed on Wednesdays, will be open on Wednesday, October 8, 2025 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. to accommodate customers that need to complete transactions at a branch during Wabash's relocation process.
