Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) Forms for Use in Indiana

A form must be approved by the Indiana state veterinarian to qualify as official certificate of veterinary inspection for use in Indiana. 345 IAC 1-1.5-2. A person wanting to obtain state veterinarian approval for a CVI form must submit a request for approval to the Office of the State Veterinarian at least 30 days prior to beginning use of the form. The request must include an explanation of the proposed form and its proposed use and include a copy of the proposed form or a method of electronic access to the form.

All CVI forms must meet the following standards to obtain approval for use in Indiana:

- The form must be designed to assure security and proper use of the form. Each document must contain a unique certificate number.
- Procedures for distribution and use of the form must include measures to assure security and proper use of the form. Distribution and access to blank forms must be limited to veterinarians.
- The form must contain fields for data entry that will capture all of the information required for official uses of the document, such as owner contact information and an animal's location and movement history, health status, health history, and identification. 345 IAC 1-1.5-2.

Electronic CVI forms must meet the following additional criteria:

- The form must generate electronic data that is compliant with the United States Animal Health Association (USAHA) XML schema for electronic CVIs.
- The company providing the form must provide information technology support for the product that generates electronic CVIs.
- The data from an electronic CVI must upload seamlessly into the USAHERDs database used by the Indiana State Board of Animal Health (BOAH).

1. Indiana's Electronic Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (IN eCVI)
Indiana's eCVI is a free, fillable PDF provided upon request to any interested
practitioner who is licensed and accredited in Indiana. Completing an IN eCVI requires a
computer, internet access to submit the IN eCVI to BOAH via email, and a copy of Adobe's
free Adobe Reader software (http://get.adobe.com/reader/).

2. AgConnect® mCVI Mobile App

The mCVI is a free mobile application (app) for Apple and Android smartphones and tablets that can be downloaded through the Apple App Store or Google Play. An mCVI certificate can be created and signed without access to the internet. The app will automatically submit signed CVIs to the state-of-origin and the state-of-destination the next time the app connects to the internet via WiFi (open the app when device is connected to WiFi).

3. Veterinary Services Process Streamlining (VSPS)

The U.S. Department of Agriculture offers a free web-based system to create electronic CVIs. It requires internet connectivity and a log-in to complete and submit certificates. This system can only be used for the following large animal species: alpaca, bison, bovine, caprine, cervidae, equine, llama, ovine, and porcine. Veterinarians must have a level 2 USDA eAuthentication to use this service.

4. Global VetLINK (GVL)

GVL's electronic CVI is an online, fee-based service that requires access to the internet to create, manage, and submit CVIs. Global VetLINK's offerings are not limited to just electronic CVIs. GVL's list of electronic services includes:

- Coggins (EIA) certificates (EquusLINK)
- Storage and retrieval of lab results (LabLINK)
- Veterinary Feed Directives (eVFDs)
- Certificate retrieval for clients through MyVetLINK.com

The USDA form 7001 "United States Interstate and International Certificate of Health Examination for Small Animals" is approved only as follows:

- A hard-copy form with a unique certificate number that was preprinted by USDA in a multipage carbon-copy format.
- The downloadable PDF version of this form only if the form has been validated by USDA with an official signature and assignment of a unique certificate number.
