

TITLE 571 BOARD FOR PROPRIETARY EDUCATION**60 Day Requirement ([IC 4-22-2-19](#))**

LSA Document #25-2

On behalf of the Board for Proprietary Education (BPE), I am submitting this notice in compliance with [IC 4-22-2-19](#), which requires an agency to begin the rulemaking process for new rules not later than 60 days after the effective date of the statute that authorizes and requires the rule unless a notice is filed with the publisher that includes the reasons why rulemaking began more than 60 days after the effective date.

The statute authorizing this rulemaking became effective on July 1, 2023. However, it took several months to gather the necessary information to perform an appropriate rulemaking analysis and to obtain feedback on the rulemaking proposal. Additionally, this rule required BPE to appear before the state budget committee before the rulemaking process could begin. Other agencies were prioritized; BPE's appearance did not occur until June 11, 2024.

BPE initiated the rulemaking process on January 22, 2025, by publishing its Notice of First Public Comment Period (DIN: [20250122-IR-571250002FNA](#)).
