1. Licensed content experts in math and English will support CTE teachers with integrating academics into their daily lessons. These individuals will be available during common learning times to assist with curricular and instructional planning as well as the development of pedagogical skills. Academic and technical integration is a priority at Area 31. These specialists will provide support with technology integration. They have also been trained in the effective use of AVID strategies, as well as structured reference, STEM integration, Project-based Learning, etc.

Evaluation Methods (Original):

There will be multiple data points used to measure the success of the Academic Integration Program at Area 31 Career Center.

- Student and staff surveys will be conducted to measure perceptual data regarding the rigor of math, reading, and writing challenges found in each program area. These will be done at the beginning and end of the school year. This will be used by staff to compare what is perceived to be challenging in the areas of math, reading, and writing are in reality the most challenging.
- Staff will use this to determine how perceptions change over time when integration of math, reading, and writing were used. Hopefully these perceptions will improve over time. If not, that is something that needs to be addressed.
- Students will use this data to reflect on their math, reading, and writing experiences during the year.

Integrated math and English/language arts success will be measured through locally developed pre and post-tests based on Indiana State Academic Standards Content Frameworks. These will include prerequisite skills that are needed in order for students to be successful in content standards in a specific program area.

 How are students, including special populations, made aware of CTE course offerings and programs of study?

Your Answer to the Question :
 We provide students and parents the opportunity to attend a virtual open house in the fall and provide program videos to share with students and parents via the web. While these options will still be available, we hope to be able to open our career center to in person visits and tours for all potential students. We will use QR Codes for students to access information about our programs and to apply for admission. Manufacturing Camps will allow current and potential students to get early exposure to a variety of CTE and manufacturing careers. During the camps, current students and potential students can get hands on experiences that will help them make future programming choices. Counselors at each of our sending schools have access to video tours for each of our programs to share with students and parents. Special populations students have access to our open house virtual tour and to all of the program videos, as well. Per our CLNA Stakeholders meeting, the importance of continuing these activities is necessary in order to increase communication with businesses and community members, to ultimately improve the image of CTE and increase enrollment and awareness and to create more business and community partnerships.

Our career center counselor does a great deal of work meeting with students to provide support leading them to success in earning high school credit, dual credit, industry certifications, work ethics certifications and employability skills. We conduct facility tours to get students interested in our CTE programs. The CTE counselor participates in activities to provide students with information and resources to promote CTE persistence and increase enrollment.

As noted in our CLNA discussion, all of our schools use Indiana Career Explorer and or Naviance to ensure that students are engaging in programs that are of interest to them and meet their future career objectives and goals. This summer, identified middle school students will attend a summer and healthcare camp to engage in CTE experiences that target our high wage high demand CTE programs. This upcoming school year, we will continue our career fairs, manufacturing day and non-traditional career fairs to present students with their unique career options.
