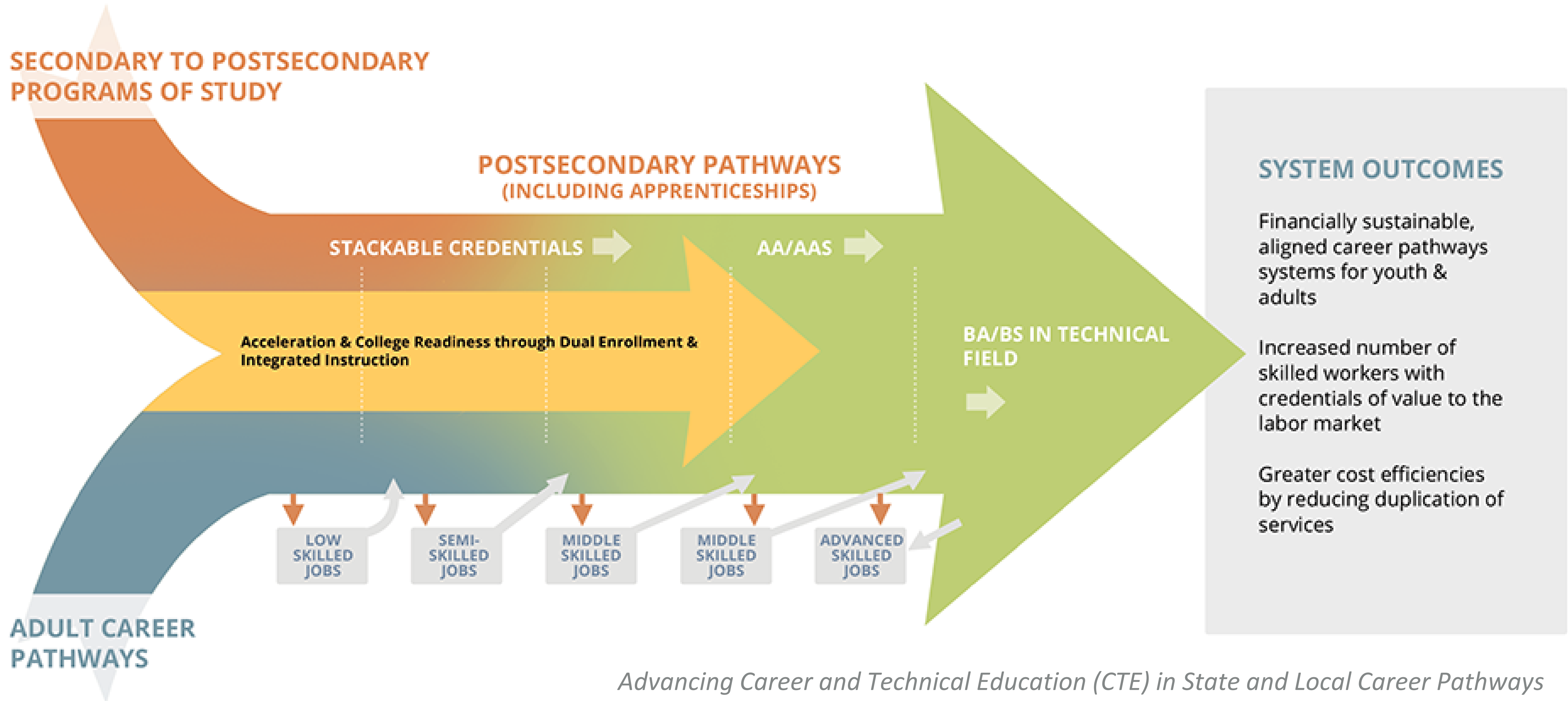

VISION FOR CTE

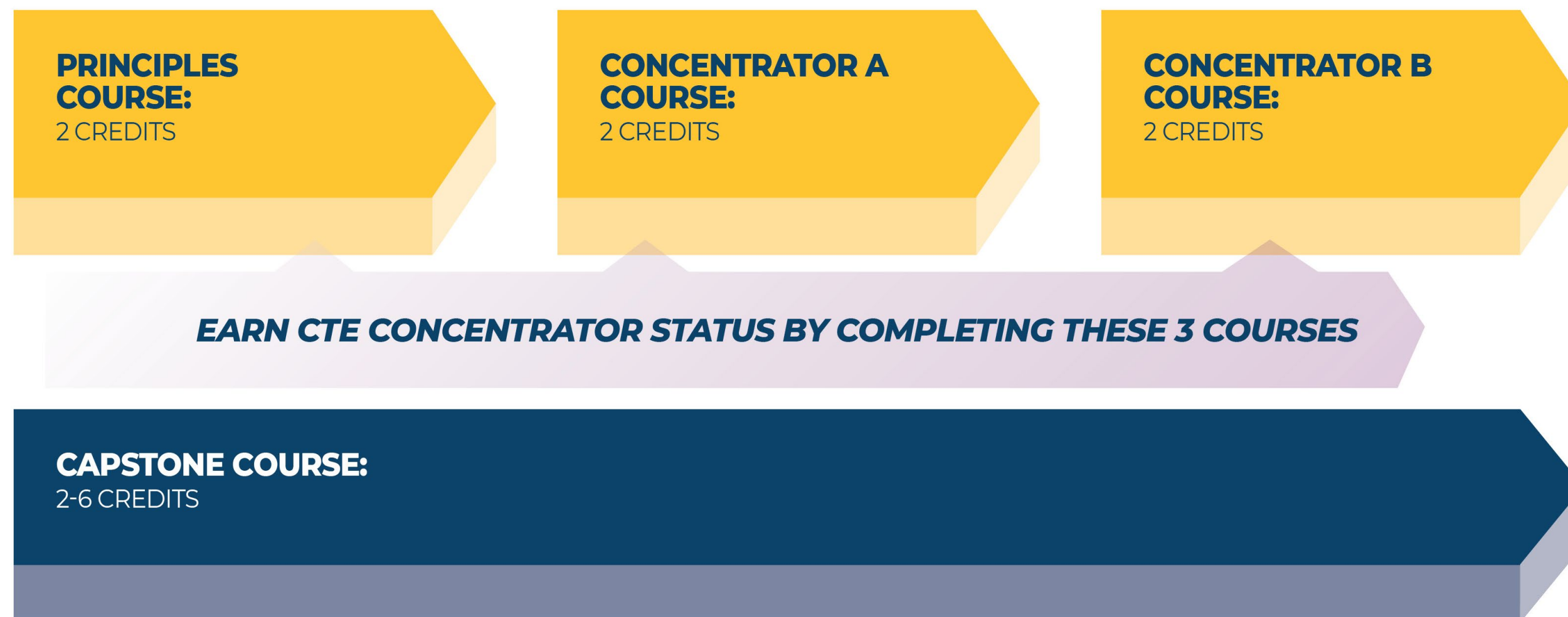

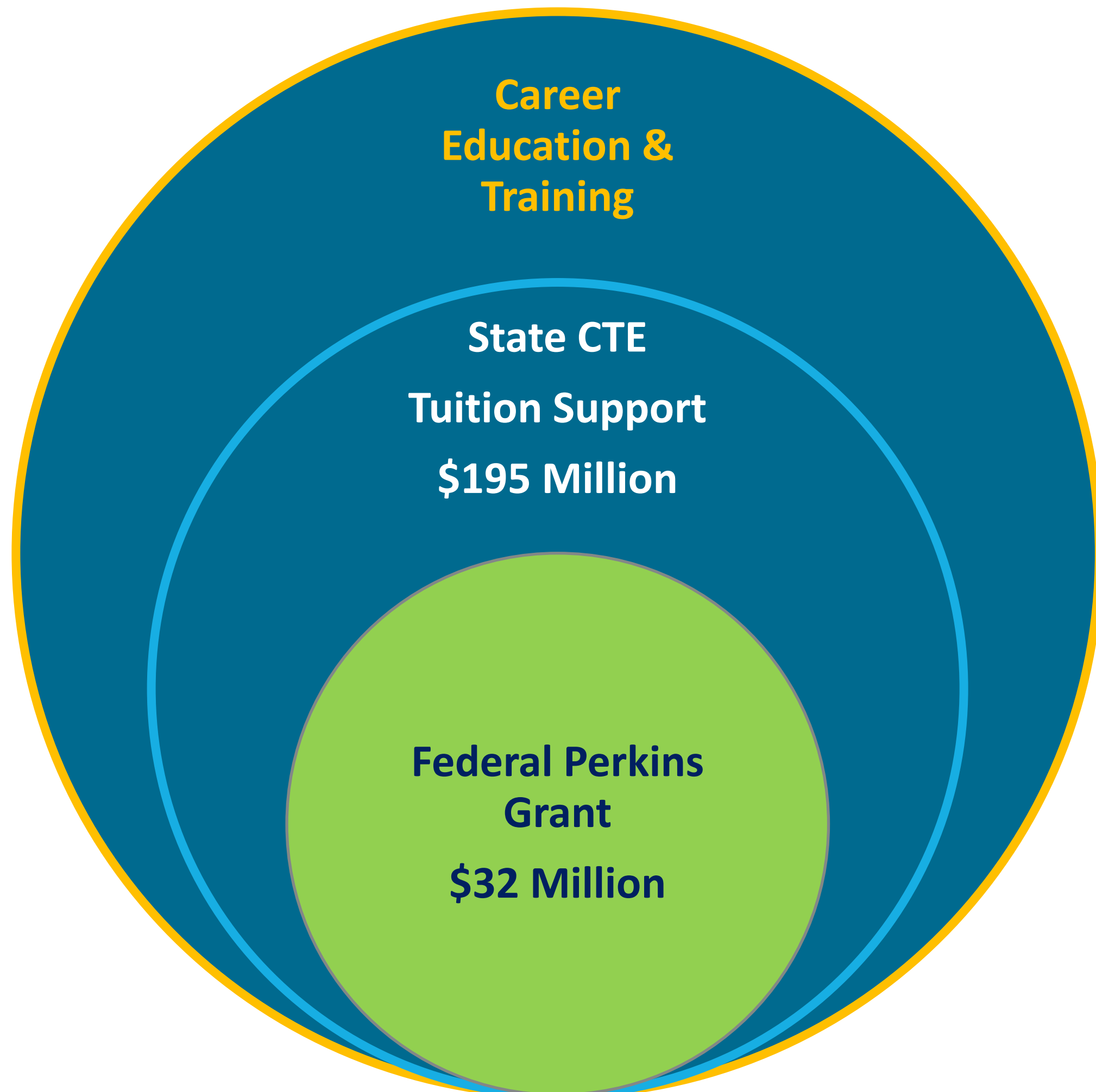


PERKINS STATE PLAN
