

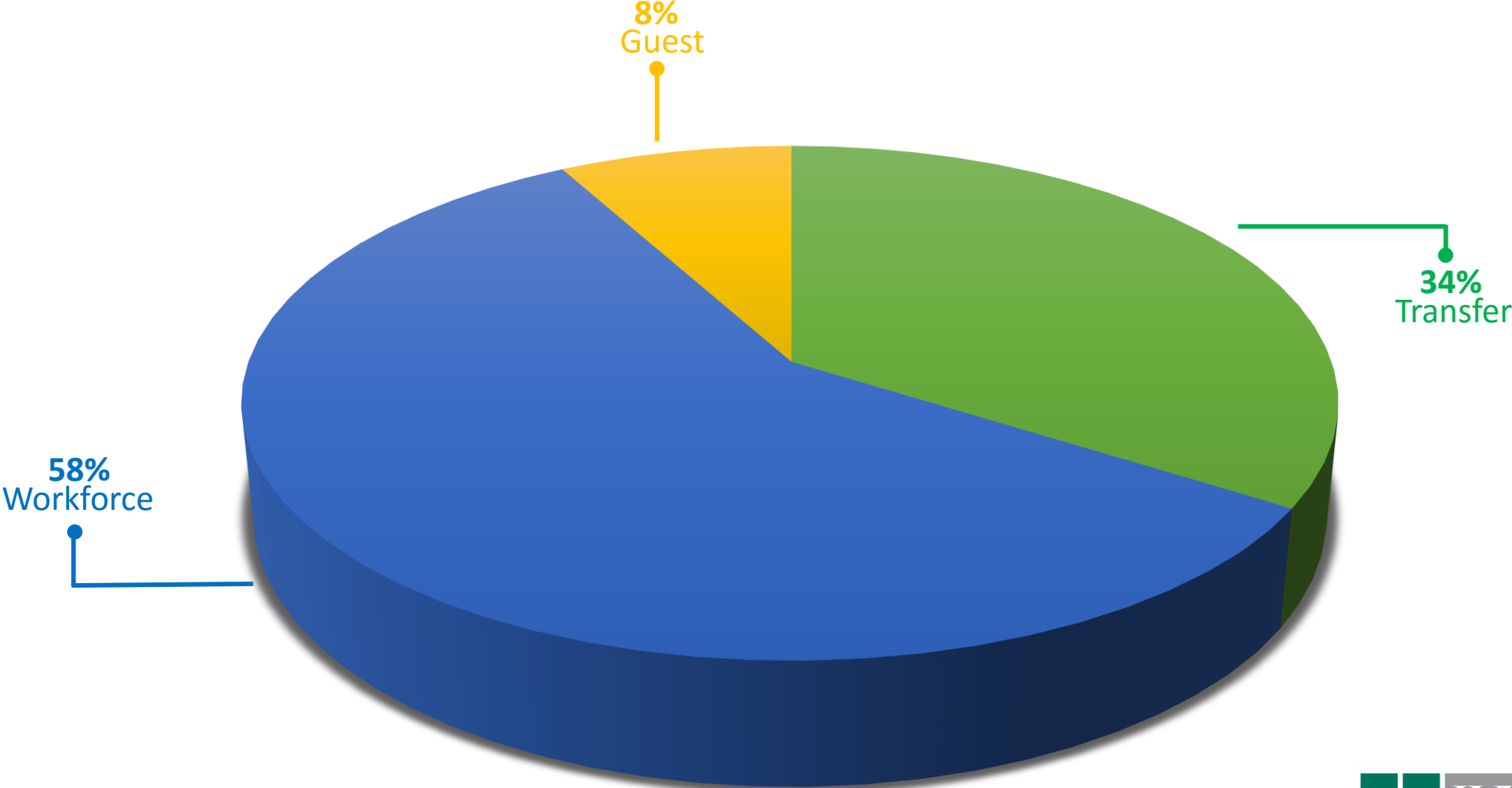

Ivy Tech Community College Student Population

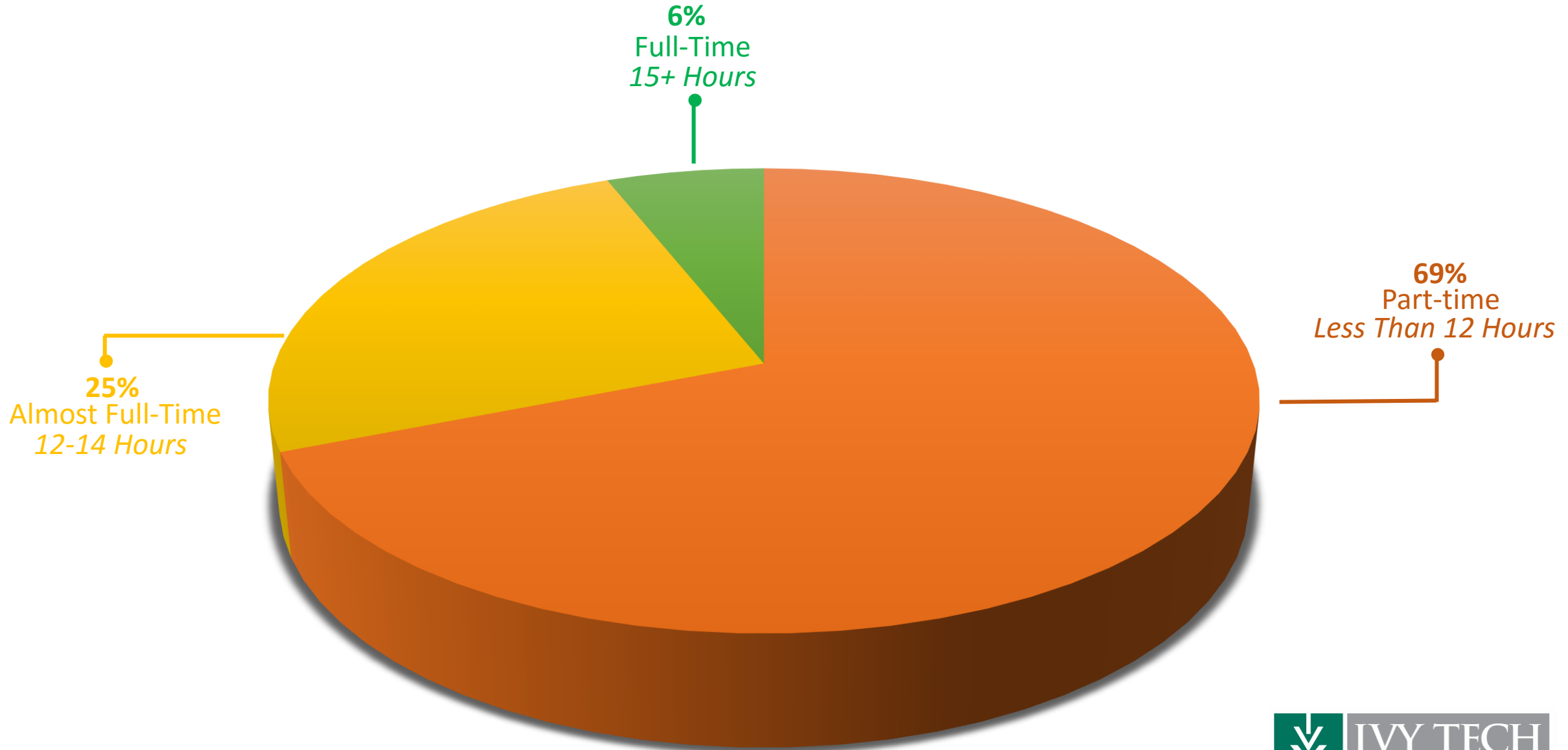


Some Measurements Tracking Students

Credit Hours Ivy Tech Students Take

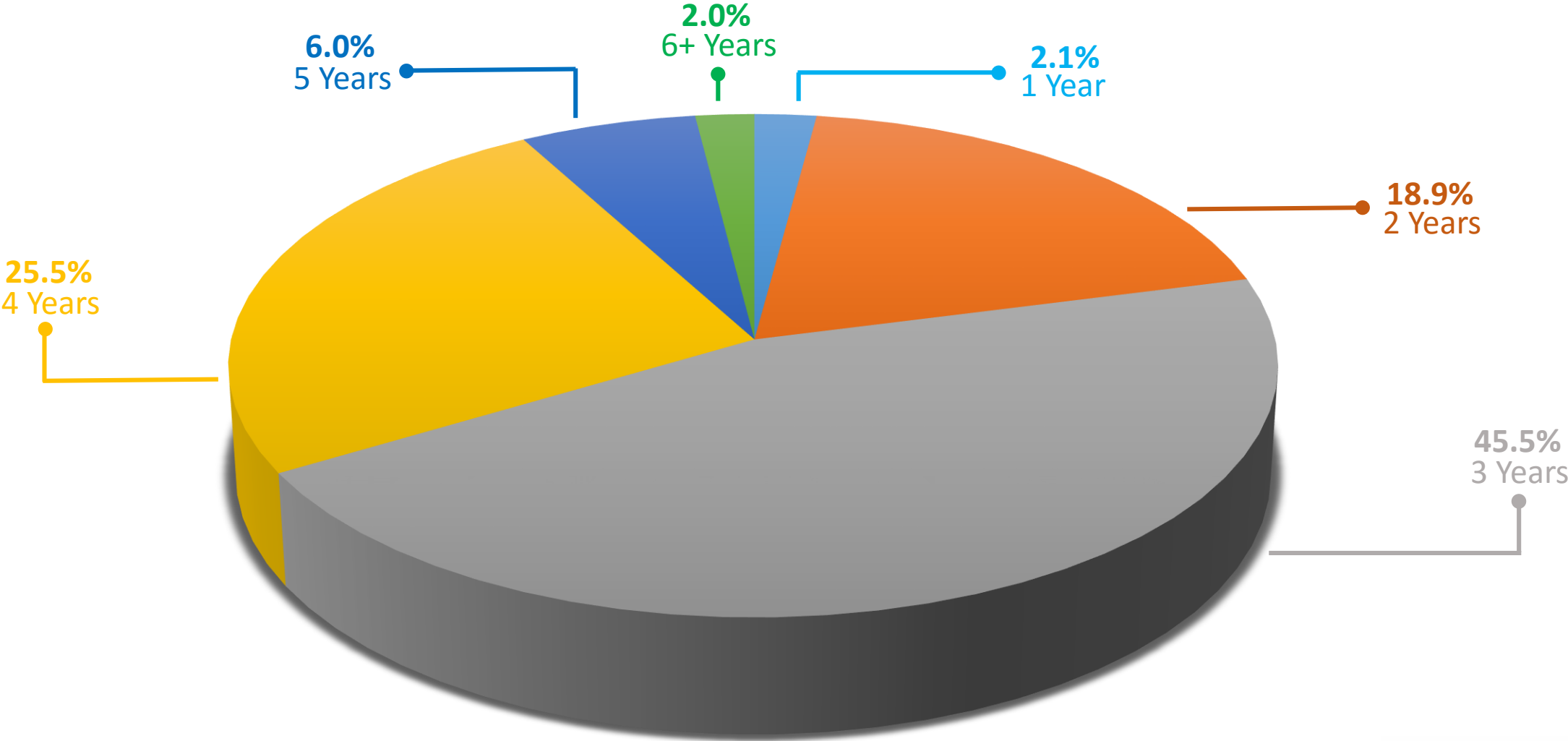

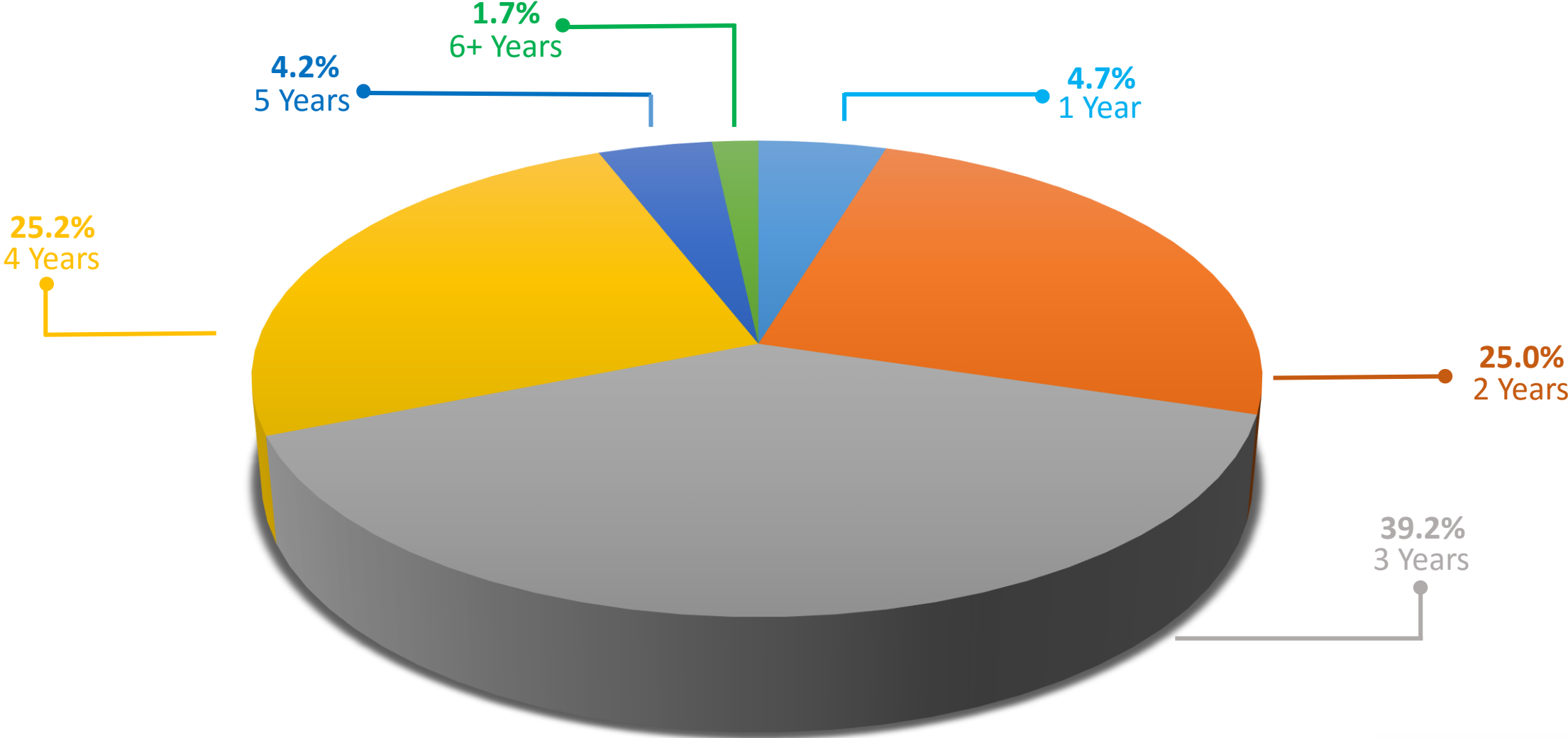

• Credentials Earned that are Vocational/Technical	71%	52%



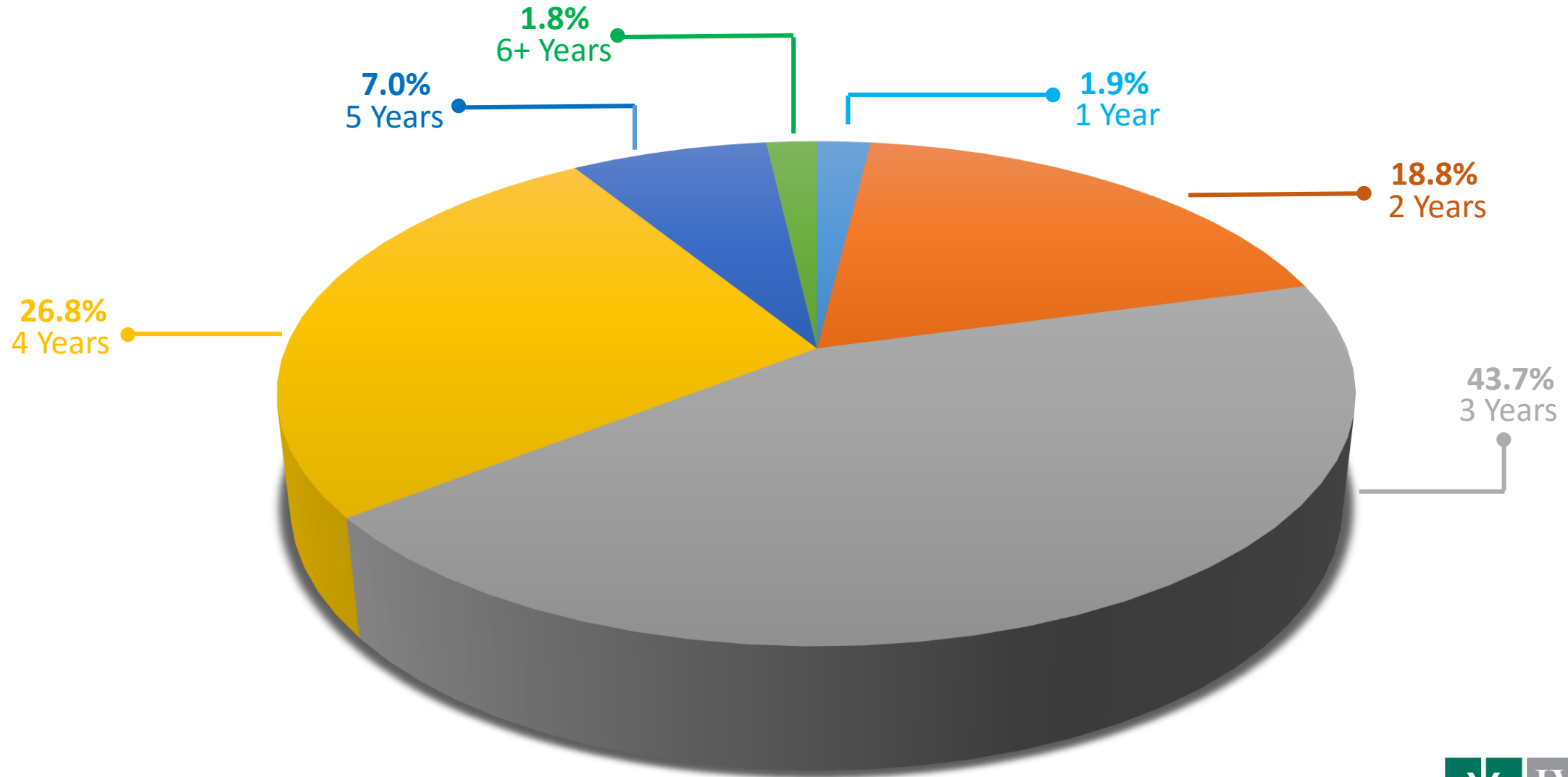
What New First Time Students Told Advisors

Building Off Best Practices

- **College Connection Coaches** – College Connection Coach program. This program is designed to provide support to high school students and help them explore future career and college opportunities. The coaches are Ivy Tech employees who work onsite at the high schools to serve that schools students.
- 73% of school counselors surveyed for the Indiana School Counseling Research Review indicated a desire to spend more time providing college and career guidance.
 - Counseling teams in high schools, that have mixed opinions of Ivy Tech as an option for students, see us a much needed “shot in the arm” to depleted staffs.
 - The Chronicle of Higher Education February 26, 2017 - *“There is no one else like her (college connection coach) in the school. Just five staff counselors serve 1,900 students, leaving little time for personalized career guidance.”*
- Connersville High School – 265 students meeting with a coach; nearly 67 percent now have next step plans for College and continued counseling with those not yet with a plan.
- Evansville and Terre Haute saw a 10% increase in applications to Ivy Tech last Fall. Now targeting a 10% enrollment increase this Fall.
