# About Reciprocity



- ❧ Tuition reciprocity – in postsecondary education, is a mutual exchange of in-state tuition privilege for specific geographical areas outside of a state.
- ❧ The Indiana Commission for Higher Education has authority to create reciprocity agreements (IC 21-18-12.2-1).





# INDIANA - OHIO RECIPROcity AGREEMENT, 2013-2015


Students from shaded counties can attend institutions in other states in all programs, with a few exceptions.

# MSEP



- ❧ Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP)
- ❧ Began in 1994 through the Midwest Higher Education Compact (MHEC)
- ❧ Public institutions agree to charge students no more than 150% of the in-state resident tuition rate for specific programs; private institutions offer a 10% reduction on their tuition rates.
- ❧ About 100 colleges and universities in Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota and Wisconsin
- ❧ MSEP is a voluntary program and only nine of the twelve states participate. Iowa, South Dakota, and Ohio do not participate in MSEP at this time.
