

- Led by MU 21st Century Staff & College Mentors
- 3-4 days long
- 40-50 Students & 10 Mentors
- On Marian University's Campus
 - Includes workplace tours off campus
- Free and open to high school 21st Century Scholars
 - Rising Sophomores Seniors

Student Impact

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- All Scholars received assistance in creating or logging into their ScholarTrack Account
- Opportunity to complete at least 5 Scholar Success Program Activities
- 90% they felt more confident about being able to attend college
- 98% understood more about the 21st Century Scholar program
- 89% knew more about career options and pathways

Tips for Successful Camp Implementation

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- Start with Learning Outcomes/Purpose
- Map out Campus/Community Resources
 - Camps and Conferences, Multicultural Center, Career Center, Grant Office, Admissions, Financial Aid, Workplaces
- Work with Legal on Minor's Policy
- Recruit & Train a Strong Mentor Team
- Connect with local high schools in October/November – summer camp registration generally goes live in December
 - Work with Marketing and ICHE
- Bilingual marketing materials & mentors
- Electronic registration forms

Budget



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- Total Cost of Camp = \$4900
 - Does not include mentor pay (FWS)
 - Previously funded through the Indiana Commission for Higher Education School and Community Partnership Grant
- Partner with Corporate Sponsors
