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
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

SURVEY AND FOCUS GROUP RESULTS


The survey was disseminated to 82 LCC coordinators, who oversee the 92 substance abuse reduction coalitions (one per county) in Indiana. There were 91 responses to the survey, and of those who started, 73 completed the survey. Forty LCCs were represented in the focus group project, or about 43% of the state's coalitions.

LCC FUNDING

For the most part, our LCCs are operating only on Drug Free Community funds. However, to supplement those funds, here's a breakdown of the counties that are taking advantage of federal, state and local support.



The main reason LCCs were unable to utilize their full allotment in any funding area was because there were not enough applicants.

TOP 5 SYSTEM INTERACTIONS

LCCs report that they are interacting with systems such as law enforcement (91%), treatment (88%), K-12 Education (87%), the judicial system (70%), and local government (67%) to name a few.



SUBSTANCE ABUSE CONCERNS AND EFFORTS

Respondents were asked to report the severity of their county's overall drug problem (scale: severe, moderate, mild, and normal), where 37 counties (50%) claimed that the problem is moderate and 34 counties (46%) claimed that it was severe.
