

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
AMENDING TITLE VII, CHAPTER 71, SCHEDULE IV, SECTION(S) 7
OF THE CASS COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, the Cass County Commissioners feel a necessity to change the traffic control device at the intersection of **CR 1250S** and **CR 1000E** in order to protect the general traveling public using public road intersections.

WHEREAS, pursuant to further continuing investigation, the Cass County Commissioners have decided that such traffic control devices need to be placed in and about such intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


Section I. Title VII, Chapter 71, Schedule IV, Section 2 of the Cass County Code is hereby amended to change the yield sign to a stop sign at the respectively designated intersection:

A. Eastbound **CR 1250S** stops for **CR 1000E**

Section II. All prior ordinances or parts hereof inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. This Ordinance hereby passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Cass County Commissioners of Cass County, Indiana, the 3 day of September, 2013.


