ORDINANCE NO. 2024-11 AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-10

ORDINANCE OF THE CASS COUNTY COUNCIL AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-10 AS TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2021, the Cass County Commissioners established a County Emergency Medical Ambulance Service by Ordinance 21-07; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2021, the Cass County Commissioners passed Ordinance 21-10 establishing fees for services provided by the County Medical Ambulance Service; and

WHEREAS, the Cass County Council desires that the revenue generated from the ambulance services be deposited into a non-reverting fund (EMS Ambulance Non-Rev Fund #4949) which, in addition to any other money provided by the County Council or provided by donations or gifts, will be utilized to operate the Cass County Medical Ambulance Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CASS COUNTY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Ordinance creates a non-reverting fund (EMS Ambulance Non-Rev Fund #4949) for revenue received from fees charged for services provided by the Cass County Medical Ambulance Services or for donations or gifts.
- 2. The money in this non-reverting fund (EMS Ambulance Non-Rev Fund #4949) shall remain in said fund (EMS Ambulance Non-Rev Fund #4949) until expended and shall not revert to the general fund at the end of the county's fiscal year.
- 3. The monies in said fund (EMS Ambulance Non-Rev Fund #4949) shall be used for expenses of maintenance of the County Medical Ambulance Service.
- 4. The monies in said fund (EMS Ambulance Non-Rev Fund #4949) shall be deposited into a checking/savings account established at Logansport Savings Bank.
