A RESOLUTION OF THE CASS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, CASS COUNTY, INDIANA, ACCEPTING TRANSFER OF SURPLUS AMBULANCE FROM CARROLL COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Indiana, on December 6, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. adopted Resolution No. 2021-<u>07</u>, A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Carroll Authorizing Transfer of Surplus Ambulance to Cass County, which declared a 2014 Chevrolet Duramax Diesel 4500 Osage conversion (VIN 1GB6G5CL3E1130255) with mileage in excess of 160,000 miles as surplus property and has transferred the vehicle to Cass County, without payment or trade, for use by Cass County's Emergency Medical Service subject only to Cass County's payment of the cost of registration and furnishing Carroll County with a receipt for delivery;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Indiana also resolved that the two (2) Kenwood radios in the ambulance shall be loaned to Cass County and returned to Carroll County when Cass County receives new radios; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Cass County resolves to graciously accept the transfer of the 2014 Chevrolet Duramax Diesel 4500 Osage conversion (VIN 1GB6G5CL3E1130255) with mileage in excess of 160,000 miles from the Carroll County Commissioners and will abide by Carroll County's request that the Cass County Commissioners immediately register the vehicle into Cass County's name and pay all costs associated thereof. Cass County agrees to return the Kenwood radios to Carroll County when Cass County receives new radios.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cass County Board of Commissioners that:

- 1. The Cass County Board of Commissioners accepts the transfer of the surplus property, a 2014 Chevrolet Duramax Diesel 4500 Osage conversion (VIN 1GB6G5CL3E1130255) with mileage in excess of 160,000 miles, without payment or trade, for use by Cass County's Emergency Medical Service subject only to Cass County's payment of the cost of registration and furnishing Carroll County with a receipt for delivery of possession of said ambulance and the properly assigned certificate of title; and
- 2. The Cass County Board of Commissioners further resolves that the two (2) Kenwood radios in said ambulance are being temporarily loaned to Cass County's Emergency Medical Service and will be returned to Carroll County once Cass County receives new radios.

- 3. The Cass County Board of Commissioners appreciates the generosity extended by Carroll County in its time of need.
- 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage.
