CASS COUNTY COUNCIL APPROPRIATION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE CASS COUNTY AREA TRANSIT SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Cass County Council has one of its primary functions and missions to attempt to serve the needs of citizens of Cass County, Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Cass County Area Transit provides transportation services to citizens of the County, particularly providing for the needs of the elderly and less fortunate;

WHEREAS, the Cass County Area Transit has recently incurred financial difficulties in providing for the transportation needs of the citizens of the County due in part to a reduction in the funds being appropriated from the State of Indiana, especially post Covid-19 Pandemic;

WHEREAS, the Cass County Commissioners has recommended a positive recommendation to the Council that the Council consider appropriating funds from CEDIT to assist Cass County Area Transit;

WHEREAS, Cass County Council independently agrees that it is in fact in the best interest of the County to provide a one-time appropriation of funds from CEDIT to assist Cass County Area Transit for shortfalls in 2024;

WHEREAS, the County Council hereby agrees to immediately appropriate \$100,000 from CEDIT Fund 9103 to Cass County Area Transit.

NOW THEREFORE let it be resolved by the Cass County Council, that \$100,000 shall be appropriated from CEDIT Fund 9103 to provide financial assistance to Cass County Council on Aging to maintain operations of Area Transit Services.
