

RESOLUTION OF THE CLARK COUNTY ELECTION BOARD

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 3-6-6-7 provides that a candidate appearing on the ballot at an election is generally disqualified from serving as a precinct election officer at that election; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 3-6-6-7(c) permits a county election board, by unanimous vote of the entire board, to adopt a resolution allowing an otherwise disqualified individual to serve as a precinct election officer; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Election Board finds that permitting Republican and Democratic poll workers who are candidates for party offices, including Precinct Committeeman and State Convention Delegate, to serve at the polling location within the district in which they reside will not interfere with the proper administration of the election when conducted in accordance with Indiana law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Clark County Election Board, by unanimous vote of the entire board, as follows:

1. Authorization

Pursuant to Indiana Code 3-6-6-7(c), Republican and Democratic precinct election officers who are candidates for party offices, including Precinct Committeeman and State Convention Delegate, are authorized to serve at the polling location located within the district in which they reside for the May 5, 2026 Primary Election.

2. Compliance with Law

All such precinct election officers shall perform their duties in accordance with Indiana election law and shall not engage in any campaign activity while serving as an election officer.

3. Effective Date

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon unanimous approval of the Clark County Election Board and shall apply solely to the May 5, 2026 Primary Election.
