

RESOLUTION OF THE CLARK COUNTY ELECTION BOARD

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 3-11-10-26 and related provisions govern the processing and counting of absentee ballots; and

WHEREAS, Indiana law permits a county election board to adopt procedures to ensure the timely, efficient, and accurate counting of absentee ballots;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Clark County Election Board, by unanimous vote of the entire board, as follows:

1. Authorization

The Clark County Election Board hereby authorizes the processing and counting of absentee ballots to begin at 6:00 a.m. prevailing local time on Primary Election Day, May 5, 2026, in accordance with Indiana law.


2. Compliance with Law

All absentee ballots shall be processed and counted in strict compliance with Indiana election law, including all security, chain of custody, and bipartisan oversight requirements. No results shall be released or made public prior to the closing of the polls at 6:00 p.m. prevailing local time.

3. Effective Date

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon unanimous approval of the Clark County Election Board and shall apply solely to the May 5, 2026 Primary Election.


