## CLARK COUNTY ELECTION BOARD MINUTES OF MEETING APRIL 28, 2025

A meeting of the Clark County Election Board was held at the Clark County Courthouse, Voter Registration Office, 501 East Court Avenue, Jeffersonville, Indiana, on April 28, 2025.

The following Board Members were present: Democratic Representative and President, Andrew Steele; Republican Representative and Vice Chairman Tony Singleton, and Clark County Clerk, Ryan Lynch, appearing by telephone. Also present were Piper Mathis and Angela Cornett, Voter Registration employees, and JoAnn Geoghegan, Secretary of Minutes. Members of the public present were Teresa Ballew, Alice Butler, Judy Robertson, Rick Robertson, and Benita Pate. Andrew Steele called the meeting to order at 4:52 p.m.

The first matter before the Board is Old Business. Andrew Steele advises that the Board has received some updated information from Attorney Klutz regarding the campaign finance complaint, which will be incorporated it into the Minutes. Kaitlyn Blessitt addresses the Board regarding the questions she has submitted to the Board. The Board acknowledges receipt of the questions and will submit the questions to Attorney Klutz. Ms. Blessitt additionally addresses the Board regarding the delay in receiving information regarding the campaign finance complaint. She advises that the amended complaint information should have been received within 5 days of the complaint, which was ten months ago, however, the response was not received until April 24, 2025.

The next matter before the Board is New Business. The Board signs the Resolution of the Clark County Election Board regarding the post-election audit by VSTOP. Andrew Steele makes a motion to incorporate the Resolution into the record. Seconded by Tony Singleton. Carried 3-0. The next matter before the Board is the upcoming Special Election. There will be six or seven machines used for this Election. Angela Cornett advises that the Election affects about 400 voters. There have been 63 early voting ballots cast so far and everything seems to be going smooth. All precincts affected and the Courthouse will be open on Election Day, May 6, 2025, from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for voting. The Board also signs the press credentials for the upcoming election.

The last matter before the Board is Public Comments. Members of the public express their dissatisfaction with the amount of time it is taking to get answers from the Mike Moore campaign regarding the complaint filed. They would like to see this issue resolved and a decision to be made regarding what action needs to be taken.

There being nothing further before the Board, Andrew Steele makes a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Tony Singleton. Carried 3-0. The next regular meeting will be May 19, 2025 at 4:45 p.m. Meeting adjourned at 5:18 p.m.
