The special election meeting was called to order by Chairman Andrew Steele.

Discussion:

Representatives from the Silver Creek School Corporation, Superintendent Chad Briggs and Assistant Superintendent/CFO Todd Balmer, presented a resolution requesting approval from the Clark County Election Board to hold a special election on May 6, 2025. The election will pertain to a bond referendum related to capital building improvements.

The board was informed that the Department of Local Government Finance (DLGF) has received a preliminary copy of the resolution. Any required adjustments will be communicated to the board within approximately a week and a half.

Andrew Steele moved to incorporate the proposed resolution into the official record without reading it aloud due to its length (three pages).

It was noted that proper notice for the meeting had been published, including notification to the News and Tribune.


Adjournment:

Andrew Steel moved to adjourn the meeting.



The meeting was adjourned at 11:34 AM.


