

**CLARK COUNTY ELECTION BOARD
MINUTES OF MEETING
MAY 19, 2025**

A meeting of the Clark County Election Board was held at the Clark County Courthouse, Voter Registration Office, 501 East Court Avenue, Jeffersonville, Indiana, on May 19, 2025.

The following Board Members were present: Democratic Representative and President, Andrew Steele; Republican Representative and Vice Chairman Tony Singleton, and Clark County Clerk, Ryan Lynch. Also present were Piper Mathis and Angela Cornett, Voter Registration employees, and JoAnn Geoghegan, Secretary of Minutes. Members of the public present were Teresa Ballew, Alice Butler, Judy Robertson, Rick Robertson, Kaitlyn Blessitt, John Croucher, and James McClure. Andrew Steele called the meeting to order at 4:56 p.m.

The first matter before the Board is Old Business. Andrew Steele advises that the Board has received some amended information from Attorney Klutz regarding the campaign finance complaint, which will be incorporated into the Minutes. Members of the public address the Board about the complaint. The Board advises that the complaint process is ongoing. If it is determined that any criminal action is needed on this issue, the Prosecutor and law enforcement will have to file that. The issue of MDL Strategies is also discussed. The public would like to know who MDL Strategies is and whether it is a legitimate company. The issues raised will be forwarded to Attorney Klutz for his response. The Board also acknowledges a Freedom Of Information Act request filed by Kaitlyn Blessitt.

The next matter before the Board is the audit to be conducted by VSTOP on the special election held on May 6, 2025. The audit will be conducted on Wednesday, May 21, 2025. The Board expects the audit to take an hour to an hour and a half to complete.

The last matter before the Board is the scheduling of the June 2025 meeting. Ryan Lynch advises he will not be available on the regularly scheduled date as he will be attending the annual Indiana Clerk's conference. The Board reschedules the meeting to Monday, June 30, 2025 at 4:45 p.m.

There being nothing further before the Board, Tony Singleton makes a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Andrew Steele. Carried 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.


