RESOLUTION OF THE CLARK COUNTY ELECTION BOARD

Comes now the Clark County Election Board, by its duly authorized members, for the purpose of increasing compensation for poll workers and absentee board members beginning in calendar year 2026;

WHEREAS, the Clark County Election Board recognizes the vital role that poll workers and absentee board members play in the administration of secure and efficient elections;

WHEREAS, competitive compensation is essential to recruit and retain qualified individuals willing to serve in these important roles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Clark County Election Board hereby requests the Clark County Commissioners to adopt the following increases in pay for election workers, effective for the 2026 election cycle

- Inspector \$225 per election day
- Democratic Judge \$200 per election day
- Republican Judge and Clerks \$180 per election day
- Training Attendance Bonus An additional \$25 shall be paid to any poll worker who attends and remains for the entire duration of required training
- Absentee Board Members \$15 per hour

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Election Board and the Clerk of the Clark County Circuit Court shall include these increased compensation amounts in the proposed 2026 Election Board budget and submit said budget to the Clark County Council for approval.
