

2026 Clay County Dust Control Program

The Clay County Commissioners have approved two different dust control plans for the public to choose from for this year. Under this plan, the homeowner will pay their half of the cost for dust control with the County paying the other half.

Great Lakes Chloride has been approved and they will provide dust control product LIQUIDOW which is 38% Calcium Chloride. LIQUIDOW is a purified hydroscope liquid used for long term dust control and road stabilization. **Cork's Dust Control** uses Crude Oil Tank Bottoms as the dust suppressant.

Both programs are the same programs that have been approved in the past. The program requires the homeowner to purchase a minimum of 300 feet of dust control. The cost, for the homeowner, for both the Calcium Chloride and Crude Oil Program is \$76.50 per 100 feet.

The County will co-pay for dust control up to and including 400 feet. Any amount in excess of 400 feet must be paid for in full by the homeowner. The cost for the homeowner, in excess of 400 feet, is \$153.00 per 100 feet.

** It is understood that, according to weather conditions, the dust control may or may not last the entire summer and fall. It is also understood that the county, depending on the road conditions, may have to add rock and grade the road during the winter/spring or sooner to eliminate any holes in the road.*

To sign up for the Dust Control Program, please do the following:

1. Call the Clay County Highway Department at 812-448-9040 or stop by the Highway Office and provide your name, address, phone number, and desired footage.
2. Mark the location on the road with flags or paint to indicate where the dust control is to be applied. Free flags may be picked up at the Highway Office.
3. The Highway Office is located at 409 N State Road 59.
4. Contact the Highway Office by Friday, May 30th, to be a part of the Dust Control Program for 2026. Treatment is planned to begin in June.
5. Prior to the dust control program, the County Highway Department may grade the road to be covered with dust control and add rock, if needed, as determined by the Highway Department.
6. Cork's Dust Control and Great Lakes Chloride will bill homeowners after the product has been applied.
7. For those having more than 400 feet applied, pre-payment may be required.
