

The Crawford County Commissioners met in a Special Session on January 3, 2025, at 1:00PM, for a Reorganization Meeting. All the members were present. Also Present was Chief Deputy Auditor Phelps.

Chief Deputy Phelps – Called the Reorganization Meeting to order at 1:00pm and opened the floor for the nomination of President. Motion to approve Morton Dale as President made by Crecelius, seconded by Ingle, Dale abstained. Motion approved with a vote of 2-0-1.

Commissioner Dale – Asked for a nomination for Vice President. Motion to nominate Larry Ingle as Vice President made by Crecelius, Dale seconded, Ingle Abstained. Motion approved with a vote of 2-0-1.

Redevelopment Commission nomination – Motion to approve Dale made by Ingle, seconded by Crecelius, Dale abstained. Motion approved with a vote of 2-0-1.

Economic Development – Motion to approve Dale made by Crecelius, seconded by Ingle, Dale abstained. Motion approved with a vote of 2-0-1.

Potaka Water – Motion to approve Crecelius made by Ingle, seconded by Dale, Crecelius abstained. Motion approved with a vote of 2-0-1.

Indiana Region 15 – Motion to approve Ingle made by Dale, seconded by Crecelius, Ingle abstained. Motion approved with a vote of 2-0-1.

Tourism – needs further discussion.

EMA Board – Motion to approve Ingle made by Dale, seconded by Crecelius, Ingle abstained. Motion to approve with a vote of 2-0-1.

Harris transfer – Motion to sign proposal for \$350 to remove prior Treasurer from checks and add Jennifer Davis made by Crecelius, seconded by Ingle. Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0.

Commissioner Crecelius – spoke about Fredonia Community Center and having lawyers look at contract and they agree that the commissioners are responsible. Will need to get bids to get it into compliance and then recommend turning it over to the council. Dale would like clarification on major modifications to the meeting with Attorney Ingle due to the amount that it may cost to remodel the building up to ADA compliance standards.

Being no further business to come before the Commissioners Meeting, Ingle motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Crecelius, Dale agreed. Motion approved with a vote of 3-0. Adjourned at 1:09PM.
