 - A. Update from Leah w/Youth Shelter re intern Tallie Davis and JRAC approves MOU in plan for development of community alternatives for period of 7/1/24 through 6/30/2025. Discussion of need for planning and funding for quarterly meetings lunch provided. Tallie will assist in looking for sponsors for lunch to be provided so we can have a longer meeting such as 11:30-1:30pm.
