**2021 BUDGET ADOPTION**

Brad Striegel called the meeting to order and led the *Pledge of Allegiance*

Roll Call – Full Quorum

Also present – Attorney Steve Langdon, Auditor Jacqueline Wenning and Sheriff Frank Loop

Dale Bagshaw led the invocation.

**1. BINDING UNITS**

**a. Solid Waste**

**b. Georgetown Township Fire District**

Denise Konkle stated that the tax rate seemed high and would like to investigate and speak with someone from Georgetown.

Motion to table the adoption of the Georgetown Fire District 2021 Budget. Moved by Denise Konkle. Seconded by Tom Pickett. Motion passed unanimously.

**c. Lafayette Township Fire District**

Jeremy Klein of Lafayette Township Fire District stated the tax rate last year was .2273.

**d. New Albany Township Fire District**

**e. Greenville Township Fire District**

Heather Peters stated this a newly formed fire district. The levy has not been set so the .2451 could be lowered if the assessed value is higher.

**Motion to adopt Greenville Township Fire District 2021 Budget. Moved by Denise Konkle. Seconded by Dale Bagshaw. Motion passed unanimously.**

**Discussion**

**Salary Ordinance** - Adam Roberts stated that the Salary Ordinance needs to reflect what the employees are being paid. Jacqueline Wenning stated that the Prosecutor Office's salaries are higher on the 2020 Salary Ordinance than the amount they are getting paid.

Frank Loop stated that the salaries were approved last year.

Brad Striegel stated that the Salary Ordinance should reflect what employees are being paid. The budget should coincide with the Salary Ordinance. Mr. Striegel stated that we need to get the Salary Ordinance in line before approving budgets.

Leslie Knable asked if someone requests more in 2021 than they made in 2020 would they reflect that raise in the Ordinance. Denise Konkle stated they requested everyone not to include salary increases.

**EDIT Fund** - Denise Konkle stated she thought that the line item in the EDIT Fund for Reisz Building Security was reduced to \$50,000.00. She asked Jacqueline Wenning to look into that.

Don Lopp changed the Election line item to \$56,000.00 but \$200,000.00 is needed. Denise Konkle will email Clerk, Danita Burks, about the exact amount needed.

**Animal Shelter** – Adam Roberts and Danny Short met with New Albany City concerning the Animal Shelter. The City's attorney sent some information that was not very helpful.

Danny Short asked David Hall why the County's portion went up 30% in the last year. He stated it has not gone up but the County has not paid their total portion in the past year.

Adam Roberts asked to see all their revenues.

Danny Short stated the County is left in the dark and has asked the City for transparency.


Susan Rosenbarger stated all they have to go by is the Interlocal Agreement with the City which states that the County pays 51%.

Dale Bagshaw apologized that the Animal Shelter has been caught in the middle.


A Budget Workshop has been scheduled on October 22, 2020 at 1:00 PM




