#### **Committee Reports**

Dale Bagshaw sat in on the Commissioner's Envoy meeting. The Commissioners are going to order an asbestos study and remedial plans to send out a RFP. They are also going to order a structural analysis. He is disappointed that they spent \$250,000.00 with Garmong and didn't have a full analysis.

Connie Moon stated that Open Door Youth Services was awarded \$140,000.00 donation from Impact 100.
