2. Floyd County Stormwater (NB#2)

a. Approval of Stormwater Business Plan and Ordinance

Don Lopp spoke on behalf of the Stormwater Board. Their ask is to change the Stormwater fee from \$39.00 in 2023 to \$64.00 until 2026 with review for continual increases after 2026. Stormwater fees have not been increased since 2006.

Denise Konkle stated she is aware of the Stormwater issues in the County. She said the Council has gone to the constituents already three times to increase taxes and they need to prioritize. She is not in favor of the increase at this time.

Ron Brown, Barrington Court, New Albany, stated he has been working with the Stormwater Board concerning his property. The homes in his area are beginning to show damage.

Robert Cox, neighbor of Ron Brown, stated he has three inches of water around his house.

Richard Shaw, 51 Hill Top Road, showed pictures of collapsed pipes.

Dale Mann, Georgetown, stated the developers need to fix the problems if it was caused by new development.

Jim Freiberger stated businesses are affected by the increase including non-profit organizations. He doesn't support this increase.

Brad Striegel stated this is a legitimate request. This is just bad timing because of all the increase requests for the taxpayers. He doesn't support it this year.

Denise Konkle stated maybe the Council can help with the healthcare cost.

Dale Mann would like to see more of an enforcement component.

Michelle Portwood stated she received the job description and was waiting on a few tweaks to be made. She was waiting on Council approval before sending to WIS.

9. Floyd County Auditor - Diana Topping (NB#9)

a. Discuss Overtime Pay for Tax Manager for Tax Set Project

Auditor, Diana Topping, asked for overtime pay for the Tax Manager for the Tax Set Project. She requested \$429.98 additional appropriation for the compensation. It was mentioned by a Council member to pay the amount instead of Comp time. Dale Bagshaw asked if, by allowing this request, they were setting a precedent on paying overtime. Danny Short stated this situation is unique and wouldn't apply to other requests.

Jim Freiberger asked what it takes to request changing the Council guidelines for the usage of the Reedy Group and Attorney as far as approval for projects and contracted work. Denise Konkle stated they would get an estimate from the Reedy Group before performing the work and an itemized statement. Brad Striegel stated the Reedy Group needs more parameters around their contract since their amount billed has increased.

Denise Konkle reviewed what was decided at the workshop on August 7. A 3% COLA for all employees unless they are above External Mid according to the Salary Study. Decisions will need to be made about the employees that are at or above External Mid and all others that do not have an Internal Base.
