**RESOLUTION OF THE FLOYD COUNTY COUNCIL APPROVING AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH GEORGETOWN TOWNSHIP FIRE
PROTECTION DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners and the County Council of Floyd County, Indiana (collectively "Floyd County") and the Georgetown Township Fire Protection District ("GTFPD"), being the provider unit of the Floyd County Fire Territory (the "Fire Territory"), desire to consolidate Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") within Floyd County in order to best serve the needs of the local community;

WHEREAS, Floyd County now finds that the interlocal agreement by and between GTFPD, as the provider unit of the Fire Territory, and Floyd County for the consolidation of EMS services (the "Interlocal Agreement") is in the best interests of the Floyd County and should be approved by the adoption of this Resolution in accordance with the provisions of IC § 36-1-7-2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of IC § 36-1-7-2, et seq., the Interlocal Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby authorized and approved by the Floyd County Council.
2. If any portion of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court or competent jurisdiction, such finding shall not affect any other portion or provision of this Resolution or the attached Interlocal Agreement.
3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately.

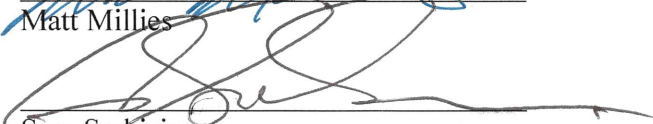

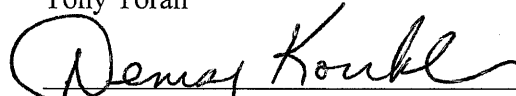

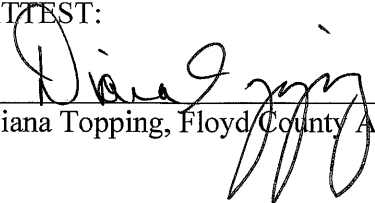
