

ORDINANCE NO. 1170-1

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. A67-4, AN ORDINANCE CLASSIFYING, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE LOCATION, HEIGHT, AREA, BULK AND USE OF STRUCTURES AND THE USE OF LAND IN THE UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY OF FLOYD COUNTY.

Section 1.

TALL BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

In the interest of public safety, comfort, morals and convenience, the vertical height of any structure or building to be erected in the unincorporated territory of Floyd County, Indiana shall not exceed 1,000 feet to the highest point as measured from the lot ground level.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect this 6th day of July, 1970.
