

ORDINANCE NO. 73-1


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Floyd County, Indiana, under authority of Chapter 174, Acts of 1947, and all Acts amendatory thereto, of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, that the Zoning Ordinance 68-1, dated the 25th day of August 1968, be amended to read as follows:


Section IV Required Improvements:


A. MONUMENTS:

1. Concrete monuments shall be placed at all external corners and angle points of every subdivided plat.
2. The boundaries of each individual subdivision lot, including corners, angle points, points of curbs and streets, and any intermediate points required by the County Surveyor, shall be marked in one of the two following ways:
 - a. By a solid iron bar whose diameter is no less than $3/4$ inch and whose length is no less than three (3) feet, or
 - b. By a hollow iron pipe of a diameter of not less than one inch in diameter and of a length not less than three (3) feet.
3. The boundaries of each individual subdivision lot, including corners, angle points, points of curbs and streets, and any intermediate points required by the County Surveyor shall be marked after final grading.
