ORDINANCE NO. FCO 84-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR OUT-OF-STATE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER INSPECTIONS

WHEREAS, Public law 120, Section 1, enacted by the 1983 Legislature and effective September 1, 1983, now permits peace officers of the state to charge a fee for inspecting vehicles which must be inspected prior to registration in the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners deems it desirable to impose a fee for inspecting applicable motor vehicles, which fee is not a greater charge for the service than that reasonably related to the cost of the service provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA, That from and hereafter the date of passage and adoption of this Ordinance, the Police Department of Floyd County is authorized and directed to collect a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) for the inspection process for each motor vehicle which must be inspected prior to registration in the State of Indiana.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED That a receipt shall be issued by the Police Department for each such inspection fee collected; that the revenues so collected shall be periodically, and not less than monthly, delivered to the Auditor of Floyd County and such revenues received from the inspections authorized

and such revenues received from the inspections authorized by this Ordinance shall be deposited into a fund for the purpose of equiptment and training for the Floyd County Police Department.
