

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 1985- 3

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LOCAL DISPLACEMENT PLAN
PURSUANT TO DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd previously adopted Ordinance No. FC-85-1, establishing an Economic Development Revolving Loan Fund, the same being funded by a grant awarded by the Indiana Department of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Commerce of the State of Indiana, as a requirement in connection with the previously awarded grant, has required as a condition precedent to the expenditure of funds that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd adopt a Local Displacement Plan; and

WHEREAS, the terms and provisions of such a Plan have been previously approved by the Department of Commerce, and the Board of Commissioners is desirous of implementing said Plan through the adoption of this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following Local Displacement Plan be, and the same hereby is adopted and shall be applicable to such Community Development Block Grant programs as Floyd County may, from time to time, undertake:

1. The County of Floyd will consider for submission to the State under its various Community Development Block Grant funded programs, only projects and activities which will result in the displacement of as few persons or businesses as necessary to meet State and local development goals and objectives.
2. The County of Floyd will certify to the State, as part of its application process, that it is seeking funds for a project or activity which will minimize displacement.
3. The County of Floyd will provide referral and reasonable moving assistance, both in terms of staff time and dollars, to all persons involuntarily and permanently displaced by any project or activity funded with Community Development Block Grant funds.
4. All persons and businesses directly displaced by the County of Floyd, as the result of a project or activity funded with Community Development Block Grant funds will receive all assistance required under the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Act of 1970, as amended.

5. The County of Floyd will provide benefits and relocation assistance to all persons and businesses involuntarily and permanently displaced by the Community Development Block grant activity funded by the State in accordance with Appendix I of grant documents, provided they do not receive benefits as part of such action under Number 4 above.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a copy of this Ordinance be forwarded by the Floyd County Auditor to the Department of Commerce, State of Indiana.
