FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 1986-4

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, that:

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, based upon traffic analysis and investigation, has determined that the existing speed limit on Old Corydon Ridge Road, Floyd County, Indiana, is inconsistent with the promotion of safety for the public traveling said roadway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has further determined that the safety of the traveling public on said roadway would be promoted by the creation of a four way stop at the intersection of Old Corydon Ridge Road and Yenowine Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently desirous of adopting this Ordinance for the purpose of establishing an appropriate speed limit on Old Corydon Ridge Road and a four way stop at the intersection of said road and Yenowine Lane.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the speed limit on Old Corydon Ridge Road be, and the same hereby is established at 30 m.p.h. The Floyd County Highway Superintendent is hereby directed to post said speed limit upon said roadway as appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the intersection of Old Corydon Ridge Road and Yenowine Lane be, and the same hereby is designated as a four-way stop, and the Floyd County Highway Superintendent is hereby directed to erect such signs, markings and other traffic devices as may be appropriate in accordance with this Ordinance.
