

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COUNTY CORRECTIONS FUND

ORDINANCE NO. 1987- FCO-7

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has elected to establish a county corrections fund pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 11-12-6-1, et. seq., and receive funding therefor from the State of Indiana pursuant to cited statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has elected to receive deposits for the county corrections fund at Level 3 funding as provided by the provisions of I.C. 11-12-6-8.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that there is hereby created the Floyd County Corrections Fund consisting of deposits received from the Department of Corrections, State of Indiana, pursuant to I.C. 11-12-6-13, which funds shall be used for those purposes delineated in I.C. 11-12-6-7, and which funds shall be administered by the Floyd County Council.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that Floyd County, Indiana, elects to receive deposits from the Department of Corrections, State of Indiana, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 11-12-6-13, at Level 3 funding.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, and that two copies of this Ordinance shall be forwarded by the Floyd County Auditor to the Secretary of State of Indiana pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 11-12-6-9.
