

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 1996- II
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLOYD COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of August, 1994 and the 25th day of August, 1994, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd and the Floyd County Council, respectively, approved certain personnel policies governing conditions of employment, benefits, and related matters; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of the Floyd County Personnel Policies entitled RECRUITMENT addresses, in part, the subject of retention of employment applications; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd that regulations appearing in 29 C.F.R. 1602 and 29 C.F.R. 1607 require that employment applications be maintained by Floyd County for a period of not less than one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of amending Section 2.13 of said policies as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED that the first sentence of the last paragraph of Section 2.1 of the Floyd County Personnel Policies be amended by the deletion therefrom of the phrase "forty-five (45) days" and by the substitution therefor of the phrase "one (1) year".

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the amendment to the Floyd County Personnel Policies as set forth herein shall be in full force and effect upon the adoption by the Floyd County Council of a resolution confirming and approving same.
