

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2004- XXIII

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FUNDS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-8-16, et seq., the Floyd County Council has established a uniform enhanced emergency telephone system fee, which fees, upon receipt, are deposited by the Floyd County Auditor in the Floyd County Emergency Telephone System Fund; and

WHEREAS, the sheriff has petitioned for funds necessary to hire additional dispatch personnel through the end of fiscal year 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has determined that the requested personnel constitutes a necessary part of the emergency telephone system of Floyd County, Indiana, and that the purchase and funding of same is authorized by the provisions of IC 36-8-16-14; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently desirous of approving the request of the Floyd County Sheriff and appropriating the necessary funds.


NOW THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED, that a sum not to exceed \$165,000.00 be, and the same hereby is appropriated so as to enable the Floyd County Sheriff to hire and train necessary dispatch personnel through the end of fiscal year 2004.
