

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2005-XXIII

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLOYD COUNTY CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PLAN TO PERMIT THE EXPENDITURE
OF CREDIT FUNDS FOR ANY LAWFUL PURPOSE**

WHEREAS, by Floyd County Ordinance 2004-XXVIII, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd (Board) duly adopted, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 6-3.5-7-15, a Capital Improvement Plan encompassing the period from January 1, 2005, to December 31, 2006; and

WHEREAS, by Senate Enrolled Act 100, enacted as Public Law 118-2005, the provisions of IC 6-3.5-7-13.1 were amended to allow CREDIT funds to be expended by a county for any lawful purpose for which money in any of its other funds may be used; and

WHEREAS, the Board is desirous of amending said Plan so as to permit expenditure of CREDIT funds for such purposes.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Floyd County Capital Improvement Plan dated the 1st day of January, 2005, be, and the same hereby is amended so as to permit the expenditure of CREDIT revenues for any lawful purpose for which money in any other county fund may be used.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that by virtue of this amendment, the expenditure of CREDIT funds approved after the effective date of this ordinance may be made without further amendment of said Plan.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that two copies of the Floyd County Capital Improvement Plan, as amended by this Ordinance, shall be maintained on file in the office of the Floyd County Auditor for public inspection.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
