

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING A STOP INTERSECTION AND DIRECTING THE ERECTION OF A STOP SIGN

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, with respect to public roadways within the unincorporated areas of Floyd County, Indiana, is empowered by the provisions of I.C. 9-21-1-3 to regulate the movement of vehicular traffic thereon; and

WHEREAS, by the provisions of I.C. 9-21-1-3(a) (7) said Board is authorized to designate an intersection as a stop intersection and require all vehicles to stop at one (1) or more entrances thereto; and

WHEREAS, to effectuate such designation, the provisions of I.C. 9-21-1-3(b) require the erection of one or more signs at such intersection to give notice of the local traffic regulation; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Engineer has recommended, based upon his engineering and traffic investigation as required by the provisions of I.C. 9-21-3-2 and I.C. 9-21-4-10, that the intersection(s) hereinafter set forth be designated as a stop intersection.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that the intersection(s) be, and hereby are, designated as stop intersections;

COBBLERS CROSSING SUBDIVISION:

The following 3 intersection to become 3 way stops.

1. Lacewood Lane at Sandalwood Drive.
2. Hadleigh Court at Cobbler's Crossing Road
3. Cobblers Court at Cobblers Crossing Road

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Floyd County Highway Superintendent, with the advice and the direction of the Floyd County Engineer, cause stop signs to be erected at said intersection(s) in accordance with the provisions of I.C. 9-21-3-2 and the Indiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.
