

**Floyd County Board of Commissioners  
Ordinance regarding Driveway Permits**

Whereas, the Floyd County Board of Commissioners met on July 6, 2010 on this matter pursuant to the creation of a driveway permit process in an effort to promote public health, safety, and general welfare of the community.

Whereas, this ordinance applies to the construction and modification of private driveways onto the County Roadway System,

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT Ordained, that the Floyd County Board of Commissioners amend the Floyd County Driveway Permit Ordinance FCO- 3 in an effort to promote public safety, ensure public health and general welfare of the community through the adoption of these processes.

**Section 5: Driveway Requirements**

- C. The driveway shall have a width at the place of intersection with the public road of at least twenty four feet (24') and an unobstructed view of three hundred feet (300') at that place.


