

Floyd County Board of Commissioners Ordinance FCO 2010 - XXI
Ordinance for Vacation of Public Way

Be it ordained by the Floyd County Board of Commissioners pursuant to Indiana Code 36-7-3-12, that:

The application filed by Rodney and Mindy Clark is requesting the vacation of a portion of the public way described as the following:

Being part of a sixteen (16) foot wide alley running east from the east side of First Cross Street, between Lot 2 and Lot 3 of Plat Number 137,

Also, part of First Cross Street running south from the south side of High Street, and being west of Lots 1,2,3 and 4 of Plat Number 137, and being east of Lots 8,9, 10, and 11 of Plat Number 135

The vacation shall not affect governmental right to those areas designated as floodways, flood plains, and/or flooding ponding areas.


This Ordinance vacating the above-described property in Floyd County, Indiana shall be in full force and effect from and after the passage by the Floyd County Board of Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT Ordained, that the Floyd County Commissioners vacates the public way as described in Exhibit A




